Brother George Washington Born February 22, 1732 at Bridges Creek, Virginia...

On November 4, 1752, Washington was initiated as an Entered Apprentice at Fredericksburg Lodge No. 4, Fredericksburg, VA. He served as the Commander-in-Chief of the Continental Army during the American Revolution for 81/2 years. Refusing payment, he asked only to be reimbursed for his expenses, which were never fully reimbursed. One of the founding fathers of the United States, he was elected President as the unanimous choice of the

electors in 1788 and he served two terms in office (1789-1797). As acting Grand Master he laid the cornerstone for the United States Capitol on September 18, 1794. On December 14, 1799 at the age of 67, Br. Washington was called from labor and was buried four days later at Mt. Vernon with Masonic rites as well as those of the church, conducted by Alexandria Lodge. Washington was eulogized by Henry Lee, "first in war, first in peace and first in the hearts of his

countrymen"
