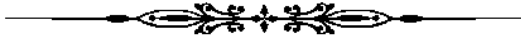

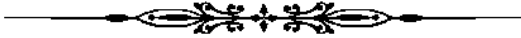

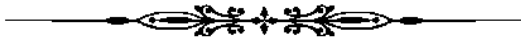

A Few Words From The East



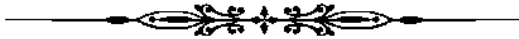
Greetings Brethren
