

Recommenders are expected to remind their candidates of their responsibility to attend and to accompany them.



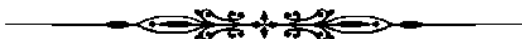

Greetings Brethren!

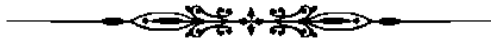
