

# A Few Words From The East



Fraternal Greetings, Brethren-

Paul Mogianesi who flawlessly gained his certification in 'business of the lodge' from the Jenkintown School of Instruction. As we continue with our degree conferrals in February, I would like to share some meditations on a section from the Closing Charge, which is recited at the end of every Stated Meeting:

"...these solemn rites, of which you have been partakers, and your parts in them, are as binding on your consciences out of the lodge as within it. They are links in that chain made in life, for eternity."

A late Brother of mine and cornerstone of my college fraternity (which was founded by Masons), once explained to me an interesting take on links in a chain. Currently, our Lodge has a wonderfully robust number of candidates receiving their degrees. I encourage each of you to join in the celebration and attend one or more of the degree conferrals if you are able. Freemasonry delivers a beautiful gift which we each received as we were forged into better men through degrees, thereby better fitting us as links in the chain of our historic fraternity. What greater way is there to show appreciation for what we have gained than to share our light with the world? Within the Lodge, we have a responsibility to offer this gift to those who are joining our Lodge. Likewise, out of the Lodge, we have a similar responsibility to share what we have learned through our actions and words.
