



Also, I am pleased to share that our Senior Deacon, Brother Paul Mogianesi did a great job in gaining certification to confer the Entered Apprentice Degree! He will be conferring the degree at upcoming extra meetings, and I hope you will be able to attend and show your support. I also have a few words about philosophy I recently learned and wanted to share with you all so you can think on how our Fraternity can be a guide in your life:

“Let no one enter here who is not a geometer” is approximately what the Ancient Greek Philosopher, Plato, had written above the entranceway to his famed Academy (where we get the word Academia from). It is no surprise why our ancient Brethren in Freemasonry use the letter “G” to symbolize geometry (or God, or the Great Architect of the Universe). Philosophers (meaning ‘lovers of wisdom’) consider geometry to represent life in its purest form - as equality, justice, and truth.
